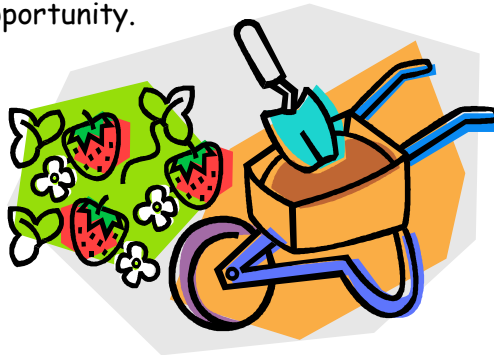

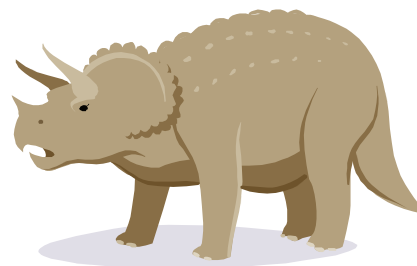
Sunbeams
