Enrollment Paperwork Checklist:

1. A completed enrollment form for **each** child you are enrolling.
2. A completed emergency medical release form for **each** child you are enrolling.
3. **An up-to-date copy of your child’s shot record** so we can make a copy for our records. We will need a copy from you even if you are already in the program and nothing has changed on the shot record.
4. Your \$50 registration fee for **each** child you are enrolling.
