Dear Parents,

Welcome back!! I hope everyone had a wonderful time celebrating with your family at Christmas. I am happy to be back into the routine of a new year. I am amazed as I walk down the halls each day at how much the children have grown in just a few short months. I know each member of our staff considers it a blessing to share the love of Jesus with your children.

Since we are entering the winter season I wanted to remind you of our bad weather policy. We close due to bad weather when Edmond Public Schools are closed. Please listen to the local television and radio stations for that information. We will not specifically post QSBC Weekday closings on the television stations; just know that anytime Edmond Public Schools are closed we are also closed. In the event that school is closed for the whole day you will receive an email or phone call from your child's teacher informing you of the closing and you may also check our website for this information [www.weekday.qsbc.org](http://www.weekday.qsbc.org). **THERE WILL BE NO REDUCTION IN FEES DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER.** I would also like to add to this that if for any reason we feel it unsafe to keep children here or that weather conditions are worsening in a way that would make it difficult for pick-up at the normal time we will close school early.

We are gearing up for Fall 2010 registration! Enrollment packets will be available the 1<sup>st</sup> of February. Those families that are currently enrolled may turn in completed paperwork including shot records and enrollment fee February 22<sup>nd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>. Spots will be filled on a first come basis. Enrollment will be open to church members March 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>, and open enrollment will begin March 8<sup>th</sup>. **ALL paperwork, shot records and registration fees MUST be turned in at the time of registration in order for your child to be placed in a class. There will be NO exceptions and all registration fees are non-refundable.** All of the necessary forms are available on our website ([www.weekday.qsbc.org](http://www.weekday.qsbc.org)) for you to download at home. This will allow you to have your forms filled out before you come. You can also pick these up at the front desk.

January is always filled with lots of many fun activities in the classroom! Be sure to check your child's calendar to see what your teachers have planned!
