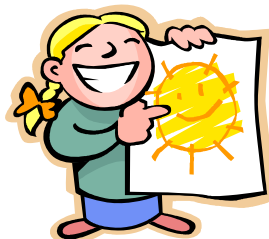
Parents,

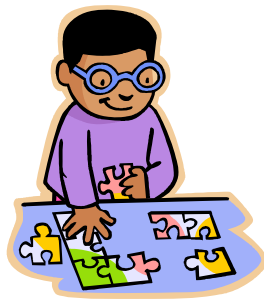
Glad Tidings

Here are a few reminders of our policies:

Tuition is due on the 1st of each month and a \$15.00 late fee will be added to those that are not paid by the 7th of the month.

Pick up time is promptly at 12:00 noon for pre-school and 2:30 p.m. for Mother's Day Out, Pre-K, and extended day pre-school. There is a late pick up fee of \$15.00 for those who are 5-10 minutes late and that fee will increase by \$1.00 for every minute thereafter. If there are extenuating circumstances and you realize you will be late in picking up your child, please call the office at 302.3023 and let us know.

Children must be symptom free of any illness for 24 hours before returning to their class. Sick children are most comfortable at home and it is not fair to other families to expose their children to illnesses. Parents will be notified in writing if Weekday becomes aware that children have been exposed to a contagious illness or disease.
